Otterbein UMC in Mount Wolf is a vibrant church that supports numerous ministries, locally, nationally and globally. Their church provides an early education center as well as an afterschool program. In addition, Otterbein Church is the location for the only Senior Center in their local community. The church also operates a separate youth center in which they currently offer weekly outreach days to kids at the local school. Pastor Mark Zortman affirms "It has been the mission of the church to provide various outreach events free to the community including a summer concert in the park featuring the Harrisburg Community Concert Band, a chili cookoff, a GAP youth center open house on Halloween, a float in the Manchester parade and a live nativity and tree memorial. These events allow the community to see the love of Jesus in a non-threatening way outside the walls of the church and to show our neighbors that we are for the community."

We were able to offer them a loan that had a significantly lower interest rate thus lowering their monthly payments.
